The Courier Company formed in 1993 and has the extensive expertise in shipping hazardous, dangerous goods for all UN Classes (1-9) worldwide and to a range of industries and sectors, including healthcare. With the provision of domestic and international specialist courier services for dangerous goods and regulated commodities and general cargo.

We monitor our activities from an environmental perspective to manage aspects that have a potential impact on the environment. We support this with the implementation and continual improvement of our Business Management System that is compliant with and certified to ISO 14001:2015.

Using our Management System, we commit to ensure we protect the environment, prevent pollution and fulfil our compliance obligations, including applicable legal requirements.

We regularly set and review objectives and targets to measure, monitor and improve our environmental performance.

The nature of our business implies leaving a carbon footprint originating from our freight and courier activities, but as we care about the environment, we have chosen to erase our negative influence on it. The Courier Company achieved 100% carbon neutrality status in 2007 and PAS 2060 Carbon Neutrality accreditation in 2010, being the first courier company in the world to do so.
